

How would you best describe yourself?



How familiar are you with APCDs?






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Rank uses of APCD data which you believe are the most important



What level of interest do you have for the following APCD reports?




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Rank the following funding sources



What type of governance structure for the Arkansas APCD do you feel is most appropiate






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What is the optimal level of reporting?




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How difficult will it be to achieve consensus on the following?

Anticipated APCD Reports

- Version 1.0 Reports
 - Population-based cost and utilization reports by geographic area
 - Average or median cost per type of procedure
- Version 1.5 Reports
 - Data extracts to experienced researchers who may serve as "beta testers" of data quality
 - Risk-adjusted population costs
 - Refresh Version 1.0 Report



Feedback from workgroups

Version 1.0 Reports

- Average Procedure Payment by Marketplace Region by payer: Private, Medicare, Medicaid
 - Expected dollars paid calculated using the average dollars paid for procedure
 - Potential dollars paid expressed utilizing interquartile ranges
 - Additional views includes mean, median, interquartile range, min, max, standard deviation, avg. # of procedures

Version 1.0 Reports

- Population-based payment and utilization by county by age range, by payer: Private, Medicare, Medicaid
 - Focuses on total dollars spent on care per year
 - Use of inpatient, outpatient (% of people utilizing), professional services (% of total dollars paid), prescriptions (% of total dollars paid)

- Support efforts to improve health care quality
- Support the development cost-containment strategies
- Provide information about health care spending and utilization
- Inform consumers, health insurance carriers, policymakers, and providers in health care decisionmaking
- Serve as a public good

APCD Operational Principles



Data Submission Practices Summary

- Best practices are evolving
- Assessment based on expert guidance and independent assessment
 - Industry recognition
 - APCD longevity of operations
- Invite stakeholder feedback from summary to be incorporated into report for agency
- Inform early 2015 data submission plan
- Voluntary and mandatory submission



- Important features of regulatory framework
 - APCD purpose, scope, and direction
 - Governance type, scope of authority, entity responsible for data collection and reporting
 - Scope of data collection
 - Privacy, security, and confidentiality protections
 - Funding sources and enforcement penalties
 - Reporting requirements



- Arkansas statutory provisions and restrictions on data use
 - AR Department of Health—prohibited from releasing data that could identify single provider, institution, or plan
 - AR Office of Health Information Technology requires patient authorization and subscribing provider
 - AR Insurance Department—limited use for investigations, market conduct
 - AR Center for Health Improvement—limited to policy analysis and research with agency permission




- Consistency in APCD regulatory framework in other states
 - All have state agency involvement, whether APCD is housed there or not
 - Few enabling statutes set forth all data submission, use, and reporting requirements
 - Many enabling statutes provide for a funding source
 - Most require data submission from public and private payers, as well as third party administrators



- Consistency in APCD regulatory framework in other states (continued)
 - All have privacy/confidentiality requirements; some
 FOI protections
 - Many require the development of a data release committee
 - Many require consumer-facing information




DRAFT Proposed Arkansas APCD Governance
